RESOLUTION G-9713

Resolution Amending Resolution G-9116 on
the Harboring of Frequent and Habitual
Barking Dogs, a Minor Misdemeanor

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, enacted Resolution G-9116 prohibiting the keeping or harboring of dogs which habitually and frequently howl, bark or yelp creating unreasonably loud and disturbing noises and disturbing the peace and quiet of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township have determined that the penalty section provided in Resolution G-9116 has led to some problems in enforcing the prohibition and convicting those individuals who violate the Resolution; and

WHEREAS, ORC §955.221 permits townships to enact a resolution and assess penalties to control such nuisances.

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to ORC §955.221, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township that:


Section 1. No person shall keep or harbor any dog within Symmes Township which by frequent and habitual barking, howling or yelping, creates unreasonably loud and disturbing noises of such a character, intensity and duration as to disturb the peace and quiet of any person in the Township. Any person who allows any dog habitually to remain or be lodged or fed within any dwelling, building, yard or enclosure, which said person owns or occupies, shall be considered to be harboring such dog.


Section 2. Whoever violates this resolution is guilty of a minor misdemeanor subject to a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus court costs.






