

**RESOLUTION G2021-98**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN A WAIVER FOR THE UNION CEMETERY ROAD LOCAL SEWER PROJECT WITH THE METROPOLITAN SEWER DISTRICT (MSD) AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENSE OF THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,000.00**

**WHEREAS**, the Metropolitan Sewer District received a petition from landowners in Symmes Township on Union Cemetery Road to extend sewer to their properties from Industrial Drive north toward Montgomery Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the work for this improvement involves construction of approximately 400 linear feet of 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer and other sanitary sewer appurtenances. The sewer is anticipated to be laid beneath the north side of Union Cemetery Road along the south side of the assessed property and will provide the assessed property with access to the public sanitary sewer located beneath the north side of Union Cemetery Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township did not object to the petition and is requesting that the assessed property at 9310 Union Cemetery Road be included in the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Township Trustees have determined that they parcel owned by the township needs sewer for future development and agrees to the assessment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio takes the following action:

- Section 1.** That the Township Administrator is authorized to sign a waiver for the Union Cemetery Road Local Sewer Project with the Metropolitan Sewer District.
- Section 2.** That the Petitioner requests that the Assessed Property be included in the sewer improvement and the petition consents, agrees and requests that the assessed property be assessed for 100% of its share of the cost of the improvement up to an aggregate amount of \$12,000.00.
- Section 3.** That the Petitioner waives all objections to the legality, amount and apportionment of the assessment and boundaries as determined and approved by the County and the right to submit written objections.

**Section 4.** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to expend funds to pay for the assessment from the General Fund or ARPA Fund (#1000 or #2272) in the amount of Twelve Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$12,000.00).

**Section 5.** The Board of Trustees of Symmes Township upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**Section 6.** It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 7.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
