

**RESOLUTION G2021-103**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE GAS TAX FUND, EMS FUND, PERMISSIVE MOTOR VEHICLE COUNTY TAX FUND AND THE ARPA FUND**

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan authorizes the use of monies for losses in revenue funds during the Pandemic;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, has determined via Resolution G2021-102 that the Lodging Tax, Liquor Permit Fees, Cigarette Fees, Fines, Cable Franchise Fees, Gas Tax, EMS Fees and the Permissive Motor Vehicle Taxes declined during the pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township is hereby authorizing the repayment of those losses from funds with monies received from the American Rescue Plan Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

**Section 1.** That monies from the American Rescue Plan in the General Fund (total received \$784,899.69) be transferred to the following funds to cover the losses identified in Resolution G2021-102:

**Section 2.** That the Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to transfer money from the General Fund to the following funds for repayment of losses Gas Tax - \$4,240.00, EMS Fund - \$10,495.87, Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax County - \$18,959.66 and the remainder of \$651,095.03 (total of \$684,790.56) to the ARPA Fund with monies received from the American Rescue Plan Act.

**Section 3.** Finds and determines that all formal action of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of

this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio revised Code Section 121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

**Section 4.** Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
