

RESOLUTION G2022-109

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES OF SYMMES TOWNSHIP TO MAINTAIN THE LANDSCAPING IN THE CENTER MEDIANS ALONG US ROUTE 22 LOCATED WITHIN HAMILTON COUNTY FROM KEMPER ROAD TO MASON MONTGOMERY ROAD

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Board of Trustees desire to install landscaping in the center medians on US Route 22 (better known as Montgomery Road) from Kemper Road to Mason Montgomery Road to beautify the township and the corridor in general; and

WHEREAS, ODOT required the TOWNSHIP to sign a maintenance agreement for the landscaping that will be installed by the TOWNSHIP in those center medians in 2023; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP provided plans of the landscaping in conformance with the ODOT design and specifications at no cost to ODOT; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost for the landscaping and the maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, desires to enter into an agreement with the Director Transportation to for their office to issue a permit for the improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the TOWNSHIP hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the agreement.

Section 2. That the TOWNSHIP enters into a maintenance agreement with the State, and that the Township Administrator be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract for improving the described project.

Section 3. That the TOWNSHIP transmits to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Resolution.

Section 4. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
