

RESOLUTION G2024-74

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO
RENEW THE CLOUD ACCESS FOR PORTABLE RADAR SIGNS FOR THE
ROAD DEPARTMENT FROM TRAFFIC LOGIX IN THE AMOUNT OF
TWELVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND NO CENTS
(\$12,900.00)**

WHEREAS, the Township Road Department is responsible for roads and sidewalks maintenance throughout the township; and

WHEREAS, numerous residents from Symmes and Sycamore Township have complained about the speed of motorists throughout the township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Trustees have authorized the purchase of six (6) portable speed signs that are located on State Route 126 (2), Humphrey Road (2) and Snider Road (2) which all require internet access to store the data that is collected by the signs; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Township Trustees that portable radar signs are a necessary safety item that needs to be purchased to try and lower the speeds driven on all roadways in the township which will increase the safety of the roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorize the Township Administrator to renew the Cloud Access for portable radar signs for the Road Department from Traffic Logix in an amount not to exceed Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$12,900.00) for a renewal term of seven (7) years (2024 through 2030).

Section 2. The funds for the cloud access shall be taken from the Motor Vehicle License Fund (#2011), the Gas Tax Fund (#2021), the Road Levy Fund (#2193) and the Permissive Motor Vehicle Fund (#2903).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to Traffic Logix in the amount of \$12,900.00 once approval has been given by the Public Works Director.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 6. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
