

RESOLUTION G2024-87

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A JOINT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WARREN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND THE SYMMES TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO FUND AND MAINTAIN SIDEWALKS LOCATED WITHIN SYMMES TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Trustees have determined that they would like to expand the sidewalk network throughout the Township which includes connecting parks to the neighborhoods located within the Township, making connections between neighborhoods, and connecting neighborhoods to commercial service districts.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires have adopted a sidewalk plan for the township and Snider and Fields Ertel Roads are listed as roadways that require sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the Township has Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Funds available for this project as it will connect several neighborhoods in the township to the commercial district where the TIF was established and benefit the district; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Transportation Improvement District is the project manager for a road widening project that involves both Warren County (Deerfield Twp) and Hamilton County (Symmes Twp) along Fields Ertel Road and will include sidewalks on both sides of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, sidewalks on the Symmes Township side of the roadway will be paid for and maintained by Symmes Township and the estimated cost for installation will be \$125,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, has agreed to enter into a Joint Agreement Between the Warren County Transportation Improvement District and the Symmes Township Board of Trustees to fund and maintain sidewalks located within Symmes Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township of Hamilton County, Ohio hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to enter into a Joint

Agreement Between the Warren County Transportation Improvement District and the Symmes Township Board of Trustees to fund and maintain sidewalks located on Snider and Fields Ertel Roads.

Section 2. The purpose of said agreement is to allow the Warren County Transportation Improvement District to install sidewalks along Snider Road from Paulmeadows Drive to Fields Ertel Road and on Fields Ertel Road from Snider to Wilkens Boulevard along with the road widening project that are in control of the Hamilton County Engineer’s Office and said township will then be responsible for maintenance of the sidewalks from this point forward.

Section 3. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
