RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE NEW SECURITY CAMERAS FOR THE SYMMES SAFETY CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF FOURTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE DOLLARS AND ELEVEN CENTS (\$14,579.11)

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Trustees have purchased security cameras for all of the parks and public buildings in Symmes Township that are owned by the township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Trustees have a need to add an intercom and camera to the vestibule and lobby at the Symmes Safety Center to monitor subjects entering the area and communicate with them to provide better coverage of the area and safety of personnel; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Trustees that all buildings, grounds, and parking lots need to be a safe place for the residents, employees, and to protect the equipment that is not being stored inside a building; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain all buildings, grounds, and parking lots for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services, employees operating within the Symmes Safety Center and the public; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator recommends that we purchase and install the intercom and camera from Professional Cabling Service (PCS) to deter theft and to keep properties and personnel safe at the Symmes Safety Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to purchase a new intercom and camera from PCS for the Symmes Safety Center in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$14,579.11).

Section 2. The funds for the cameras shall be paid from the Safety Services Fund (#2196).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to PCS in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$14,579.11) upon final approval of the Public Works Director.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.



Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.







- Install, terminate, test, and label Qty (2) white cat6 cables from Server Room to Each Camera Location
- Install, terminate, test, and label Qty (1) white cat6 cables from Server Rack to Access Control Panel
- Install Qty (1) I8307-VE Video Intercom in front vestibule replacing existing intercom
- Install Qty (1) AXIS P3265-LV 2MP Indoor Dome Camera in Main Lobby
- Install Access Control Panel/PSU & AXIS A1810-B PbG 8-door controller in Server Room
- Install Qty (1) Composite Access Control Cable from Server Room Access Control Panel to Inner Vestibule Door.
- Install DPS and Rex on Inner Vestibule Door. Tie into existing Locking Hardware
- Provide Qty (2) Genetec Camera Connection Licenses
- Provide Qty (1) Genetec Reader Connection License
- Configure cameras and integrate into existing Genetec System.
- PoE+ Ports by others.
