



RESOLUTION G2025-81

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF APPARATUS PARTS AND REPAIRS FROM HERITAGE FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR TOWER 61 IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHT DOLLARS AND EIGHTEEN CENTS (\$13,908.18)

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by the Fire Chief and determined by the Trustees that they would like to purchase parts and have apparatus repaired; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain the equipment for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township Public Safety Divisions and the general public; and

WHEREAS, Symmes Township participates in the Ohio State Term Contract program therefore the Township would not be required to bid out the equipment to multiple vendors; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §505.37, the Board of Trustees may purchase, lease, lease with an option to purchase, or otherwise provide any fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment, appliances, materials, fire hydrants, and water supply for firefighting and fire and rescue purposes that seems advisable to the board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Board of Township Trustees hereby authorizes the purchase of apparatus parts and repairs for Tower 61 from Heritage Fire Equipment for pump repairs in the amount of Thirteen Thousand Nine Hundred Eight Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$13,908.18).

Section 2. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to expend funds to pay Heritage Fire Equipment in the amount not to exceed Thirteen Thousand Nine Hundred Eight Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$13,908.18) from the Safety Services Fund (#2196) once the equipment has been repaired and the Fire Chief has given final approval of the project.

Section 3. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.






