



RESOLUTION G2018-06

**AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING A TEMPORARY ADVANCE
OF THIRTY-THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED (\$33,700.00) DOLLARS
FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE LIGHTING ASSESSMENT FUND**

WHEREAS, advances can be made from a less restricted fund to a more restrictive fund;
and

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Administrator has advised that the Lighting Assessment Fund (Fund 07) will not have enough funds to pay for the lighting bills until tax assessments are received and transferred to Symmes Township via the Hamilton County Auditor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Administrator has further advised that the anticipated revenue stream for the Lighting Assessment Fund (Fund 07) will be sufficient to meet the budgeted expenditures for 2018 and for the repayment of this advance; and

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Administrator is requesting a temporary advance of Thirty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred (\$33,700.00) Dollars from the General Fund (Fund 01) to the Lighting Assessment Fund (Fund 07) until such time as the anticipated revenue is received from the Hamilton County Auditor's Office in 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Symmes Township Board of Trustees, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Board of Trustees hereby authorizes a temporary advance of Thirty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred (\$33,700.00) Dollars from the General Fund (Fund 01) to the Lighting Assessment Fund (Fund 07) with an anticipated estimated repayment date of April and/or September, 2018.

Section 2. The transfer of funds from a General Fund (Fund 01) to any other fund of the Township is authorized pursuant to Section 5705.14(E) of the Ohio Revised Code and therefore this Resolution may be adopted upon a single reading and shall become effective upon the date of its adoption.



Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.


Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


