



RESOLUTION G2025-88

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE NEW AUDIO AND VISUAL EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES FROM PROFESSIONAL CABLING SOLUTIONS (PCS) FOR THE SYMMES SAFETY CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORTY-ONE CENTS (\$19,638.41)

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Trustees have purchased audio and visual equipment for the meeting room at Symmes Safety Center; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain all buildings, parks, and parking lots for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township staff and the public; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Township Administrator that the equipment currently at the Symmes Safety Center is obsolete and must be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator recommends that we buy new audio-visual equipment and accessories from Professional Cabling Service (PCS) to replace obsolete equipment and update to more reliable equipment and technology to efficiently operate the township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to purchase new audio-visual equipment and accessories from PCS for the meeting room that is located at the Symmes Safety Center in the amount of Nineteen Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars and Forty-One Cents (\$19,638.41).

Section 2. The funds for the cameras shall be paid from the Safety Services Levy Fund (#2196).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to PCS in the amount of \$19,638.41 upon final approval of the Township Administrator.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

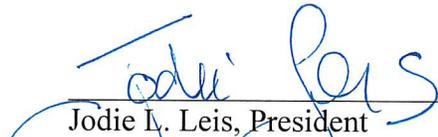

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

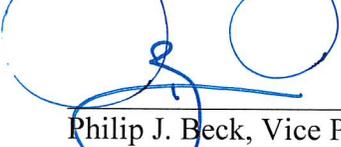
