



RESOLUTION G2025-84

AMENDING RESOLUTION G-9713 ON THE HARBORING OF FREQUENT AND HABITUAL BARKING DOGS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, enacted Resolution G-9713 regulating the keeping or harboring of frequent and habitual barking dogs; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that is necessary to amend the penalty section in order to be consistent with state law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. No person shall keep or harbor any dog within Symmes Township which by frequent and habitual barking, howling or yelping, creates unreasonably loud and disturbing noises of such a character, intensity and duration as to disturb the peace and quiet of any person in the Township. Any person who allows any dog habitually to remain or be lodged or fed within any dwelling, building, yard or enclosure, which said person owns or occupies, shall be considered to be harboring such dog.

Section 2. Whoever violates this resolution is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

Section 3. That the Board finds and determines that all formal action of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio revised Code Section 121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.






