



RESOLUTION G2017-29

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER
INTO A JOINT AGREEMENT BETWEEN HAMILTON COUNTY AND THE
BOARD OF TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES OF SYMMES TOWNSHIP FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO CUNNINGHAM ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees recently approved resolution G2017-07 to contract with Barrett Paving to pave certain township roadways in the Camp Dennison area; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended to the County Engineer to pave three (3) additional roadways in the same area that are under the control and maintenance of the County Engineer's Office which includes Cunningham, Lincoln and Camp Roads; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer's Office desires to resurface/rehabilitate Cunningham Road from the Indian Hill Corp Line to SR126 and have agreed to reimburse the township up to \$32,000.00 for that resurfacing/rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, has agreed to enter into a Joint Agreement Between Hamilton County and the Board of Township Trustees of Symmes Township for the Construction of Improvements to Cunningham Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

- Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township of Hamilton County, Ohio hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to enter into a Joint Agreement Between Hamilton County and the Board of Township Trustees of Symmes Township for the construction of improvements to Cunningham Road.
- Section 2. The purpose of said agreement is to resurface/rehabilitate Cunningham Road which is a county maintained roadway and the County Engineer has agreed to reimburse Symmes Township up to \$30,000.00 for those improvements upon receipt of an invoice from Symmes Township for the work performed.
- Section 3. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all

deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
