



RESOLUTION G2014-06

Authorizing and Directing a Temporary Advance
of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars
from the General Fund to the Lighting Assessment Fund

WHEREAS, advances can be made from a less restricted fund to a more restrictive fund;
and

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Fiscal Officer has advised that the Lighting
Assessment Fund (Fund 07) will experience a cash flow situation due to the receipt of revenue
from the Hamilton County Auditor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Fiscal Officer has further advised that the anticipated
revenue stream for the Lighting Assessment Fund (Fund 07) is sufficient to meet the budgeted
expenditures for 2014 and for the repayment of this advance; and

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Fiscal Officer is requesting a temporary advance of
Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars from the General Fund (Fund 01) to the Lighting
Assessment Fund (Fund 07) until such time as the anticipated revenue is received from the
Hamilton County Auditor's Office in 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Symmes Township Board of Trustees,
Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Board of Trustees hereby authorizes a temporary
advance of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars from the General Fund
(Fund 01) to the Lighting Assessment Fund (Fund 07) with an anticipated
estimated repayment date of May, 2014.


Section 2. The transfer of funds from a General Fund (Fund 01) to any other fund of

reading and shall become effective upon the date of its adoption.






