



RESOLUTION G2025-99

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE A WORK TRUCK FOR THE ROAD DEPARTMENT FROM MCCLUSKEY CHEVROLET IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY-ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$61,515.00)

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Public Works Director that a new work truck is needed by the Service Department and will be used for multiple tasks, specifically maintenance tasks within our safety services buildings; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Trustees that they typically replace vehicles for the Police and Service Department on a six-year rotation plan or more than 100,000 miles; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees did budget to replace the truck this year; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain the roads and parks for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the general public; and

WHEREAS, Service Department has one (1) vehicle dedicated to maintenance tasks relating to the Township's safety services buildings that Symmes Township purchased in 2008 and has maintained over the last 17 years which has approximately 85,000 miles on it and needs to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, Symmes Township participates in the Ohio State Bid program therefore the Township would not be required to bid out the truck to multiple vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Trustees have decided to add the work truck to the Service Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to purchase a new work truck from McCluskey Chevrolet and outfit the truck from McCluskey Chevrolet in an amount

not to exceed Sixty-One Thousand Five Hundred Fifteen Dollars and No Cents (\$61,515.00).

Section 2. The funds for the work truck shall be taken from the Safety Services Fund (2196).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to McCluskey Chevrolet in an amount not to exceed \$61,515.00 once the truck has been delivered and the Public Works Director has given final approval.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

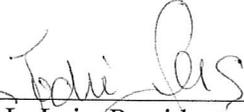

Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

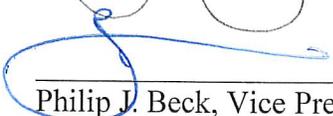

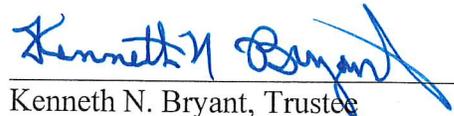

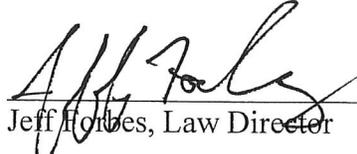
