### **Fields-Ertel Road Widening Project to Resume**

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio and Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio – Fields-Ertel Road, between Snider Road and Wilkens Blvd., construction will resume on the south side of Fields-Ertel Road on Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026. The contractor shall continue construction to widen Fields-Ertel Road from two (2) lanes to five (5) lanes.

This project is being constructed by the John R. Jurgensen Company for a bid amount of \$18,611,588.44. This project is funded by the Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant, Ohio Public Works Commission, Deerfield Township Trustees, Symmes Township Trustees, Hamilton County Engineer's Office, and Warren County Engineer's Office through the Warren County Transportation Improvement District.

*County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
