

RESOLUTION G2020-94

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,026.70 FOR A MOBILE HOT STEAM DISINFECTING AND CLEANING PRESSURE WASHER THROUGH ENZOS CLEANING SOLUTIONS AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Board of Trustees currently have shelters, picnic tables, benches and playground equipment that is hard to clean and sanitize every day; and

WHEREAS, the Township Director of Public Works is requesting to purchase a mobile hot steam disinfecting and cleaning pressure washer that will sanitize surfaces and will be safe for the employees and the community due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator has recommended that we purchase this system so that the employees can clean the surfaces in the park shelters and the playgrounds to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and to make the public feel safer using the equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Township Trustees have determined that they want to keep the shelters and all surfaces in the parks clean and sanitized and approve the expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$15,026.70.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

- Section 1.** That the Symmes Township Board of Trustees hereby approve the purchase of a mobile hot steam disinfecting and cleaning pressure washer to be used in the parks to clean and sanitize the shelters, picnic tables, benches and the playground equipment.
- Section 2.** The Board hereby authorizes the Administrator to spend an amount not to exceed \$15,026.70 for the equipment.
- Section 3.** The Board of Township Trustees hereby authorizes and directs the Township Fiscal Officer to expend such funds from the CARES ACT Fund (#14L) in an amount not to exceed \$15,026.70.
- Section 4.** Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.
- Section 5.** Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and

that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
