**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN AN
ACCEPTANCE/EXECUTION OF THE PERMANENT
SIDEWALK EASEMENTS, STORM SEWER EASEMENTS
AND TEMPORARY RIGHTS OF ENTRY AND
CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT AGREEMENTS FOR THE
UNION CEMETERY ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Symmes Township has undertaken the acquisition of sidewalk and storm sewer easements, along with temporary rights of entry; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township has authority pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10(A) to accept the permanent and temporary easements regarding real property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that construction of sidewalk easements and a drainage sewer along Union Cemetery Road will further the public purpose of safe pedestrian access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees of Symmes Township is hereby authorized to accept and/or execute Permanent Sidewalk and Drainage Easements, substantially as set forth and attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference, and authorizes the Township Administrator to sign the Easements.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees hereby accepts the Temporary Rights of Entry and Construction Easement Agreements, substantially as set forth and attached hereto as Exhibit “B” and incorporated herein by reference and authorizes the Township Administrator to sign the Agreements.

Section 3. The Permanent Sidewalk and Drainage Easements and Temporary Rights of Entry and Construction Easement are for the public purpose, to-wit: For the purpose of safe pedestrian access along Union Cemetery Road.

Section 4. Upon majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committee that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code 121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
