

**RESOLUTION G2021-29**

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SEPARATE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 9001  
TO ESTABLISH A CUSTODIAL FUND IN THE UAN ACCOUNTING SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, there was a fire on Danial Avenue in Camp Dennison on January 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, per Ohio Revised Code Section 3929.86, the township is permitted to adopt a Resolution that authorizes insurance companies under certain circumstances to pay to the Township a portion of the insurance proceeds to ensure that a fire damaged building or structure is removed, repaired, or secured; and

**WHEREAS**, Symmes Township adopted Resolution G-0719 which requires the insurance companies to pay a proceed to the township to cover any costs associated with removal, repairs, or securing the building if needed; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution G-0719 specifies that the bond must be submitted in the amount of \$2,000.00 for each \$15,000.00 of value for the estimate of repairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Chief for the Loveland Symmes Fire Department recommends to the board of Trustees of Symmes Township Trustees establish the fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

**Section 1.** The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorize the creation of a separate special revenue fund 9001 in the UAN system to be compliant with the requirements of Resolution G-0719 and Section 3929.86 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 2.** That permanent appropriations shall be set for this new fund in the amount of \$28,796.86 and the following line items be established; 9001-885-0000 for a revenue fund and 9001-789-990-0000 Other Financing \$28,796.86 for appropriations.

**Section 3.** Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**Section 4.** It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
