

RESOLUTION G2021-22

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE SNOW REMOVAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE PARKS DEPARTMENT FROM KE ROSE COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE DOLLARS AND NO CENTS \$8,495.00

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Township Trustees that they would like to perform snow removal and salt all existing paved trails in the township parks; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has determined that they will need additional equipment to perform snow removal activities that will be used by the Parks Department employees for the trail system in each park; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees did not budget to purchase this additional equipment; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain the parks for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the public; and

WHEREAS, Symmes Township participates in the Ohio State Bid program therefore the Township would not be required to bid out the truck to multiple vendors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to purchase snow removal equipment for the parks department in the amount of \$8,495.00.

Section 2. The funds for the snow equipment shall be taken from the Parks Levy Fund (#2171).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to KE Rose Company in the amount of \$8,495.00 once the equipment has been delivered and the Public Works Director has given final approval.

Section 4. Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public,

incompliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 5. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
