

**RESOLUTION G2022-96**

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SEPARATE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 2904  
WITHIN THE UAN TO ACCOUNT FOR OPIOID SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio reached an \$808 million dollar agreement with the three largest distributors of opioids and the state developed the OneOhio plan, a mechanism to ensure that any money from a negotiated settlement is distributed fairly to the communities hit hardest by the opioid crisis; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.09(F) requires subdivisions to establish separate funds for each class of revenue derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.10(I) states that money paid into a fund must be used only for the purposed for which said fund is established; and

**WHEREAS**, Symmes Township has requested and received a portion of its share of funds from the Opioid Settlement Proceeds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

**Section 1.** The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorize the creation of a separate special revenue fund 2904 within the UAN system to be compliant with the requirements of all applicable laws and regulations and shall be used for the sole purpose of meeting the Opioid strategies as outlined in the MOU.

**Section 2.** That the revenue code of 2904-892-0000 be established and the following line items be established for appropriations: 2904-230-420-0000 Operating Supplies and 2904-230-599-0000 Other.

**Section 3.** Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**Section 4.** It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised

Code.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
