

RESOLUTION G2022-94

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP
LAW DIRECTOR TO FILE A PETITION FOR APPROPRIATION OF CERTAIN
PROPERTY LOCATED NEAR KUGLER MILL AND COMMONLY
REFERRED TO AS A MEMORIAL PARK**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township has previously found that it is necessary and in the best interest to acquire two “orphaned” parcels of property for the assemblage of a memorial park described on Exhibits “A” and “B”; and

WHEREAS, the Township has been unable to locate the owners, and therefore cannot agree with one or more of the owners of the property mentioned herein as to the value of said acquisition; and

WHEREAS, Resolution G-2022-68 has been adopted declaring the necessity and intention to appropriate said property; and

WHEREAS, notice of the adoption of said Resolution G-2022-68 has been given according to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Township Law Director is hereby authorized and directed to file a petition for the appropriation of property in the Court of Common Pleas of Hamilton County for the purpose of having a jury impaneled to make inquiry into and assess the compensation to be paid for the underlying ownership interest in real estate described in Exhibits “A” and “B”. The purpose of this appropriation is to unify ownership of certain real property in furtherance of the assemblage of necessary property for use as a memorial park.

Section 2. The Trustees of Symmes Township upon a majority vote do hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law, following the filing of this Resolution with the Symmes Township Fiscal Officer.

Section 4. It is hereby determined that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board of Township Trustees and that all deliberations of such Board

of Trustees were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
