

RESOLUTION G2022-87

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH CHOICE ONE ENGINEERING FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE TIMBERLAKE DRIVE STORM OUTLET PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,100.00

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works is recommending that the Trustees install a new storm outlet from the end of Timberlake Drive to a catch basin on I-71 due to the excessive amount of water on the street after storms; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that the Board of Township Trustees hire Choice One Engineering to complete the necessary engineering to provide bid documents for contractors to review prior to bidding; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §5571.01, the Board of Trustees may construct, reconstruct, resurface, or improve any public road or part thereof under its jurisdiction within its township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio takes the following action:

- Section 1.** That the Township Administrator is authorized to sign an agreement or necessary paperwork with Choice One Engineering, 440 E. Hoewisher Road, Sidney, Ohio 45365, to provide engineering services for the Timberlake Drive Storm Outlet Project, in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Sixteen Dollars and No Cents (\$16,100.00).
- Section 2.** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to expend funds to pay Choice One Engineering from the Gas Tax Fund (#2021) in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Sixteen Dollars and No Cents (\$16,100.00).
- Section 3.** The Board of Trustees of Symmes Township upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.
- Section 4.** It is hereby certified that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its

committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
