

RESOLUTION G2022-48

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE SECURITY CAMERAS FOR THE CAMP DENNISON NATURE TRAIL AND SEVEN GABLES PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF ELEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHT DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-ONE CENTS (\$11,708.71)

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Trustees have purchased security cameras for most of the parks and public buildings in Symmes Township that are owned by the township; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Trustees that all buildings and parking lots need to be a safe place for the residents, employees, and to protect the equipment that is not being stored inside a building; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain all buildings and parking lots for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the public; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator recommends that we purchase cameras from Professional Cabling Service (PCS) to deter theft and to keep properties safe at Seven Gables Park and the Camp Dennison Nature Trail.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to purchase cameras from PCS for the Camp Dennison Nature Trail and Seven Gables Park lot in the amount of Eleven Thousand Seven Hundred Eight Dollars and Seventy-One Cents (\$11,708.71).

Section 2. The funds for the cameras shall be paid from the Parks Fund (#2171).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to PCS in the amount of \$11,708.71 upon final approval of the Public Works Director.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of

Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
