

RESOLUTION G2022-49

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE REPLACEMENT PARTS FOR THE LEMMING PLAYGROUND AND TO PERFORM TURF MAINTENANCE UNDERNEATH/SURROUNDING THE STRUCTURE FROM PES IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND FIFTY-FOUR CENTS (\$12,326.54)

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Trustees purchased a new playground for the Lemming shelter area back in 2018; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Public Works Director that there are parts that need to be replaced at the playground and turf maintenance must be performed underneath and surrounding the structure; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain all buildings, structures, and parking lots for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the public; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator recommends that we purchase these replacement parts for the Lemming Playground and perform turf maintenance underneath and surrounding the structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to purchase replacement parts for the Lemming Playground and to perform turf maintenance underneath and surrounding the structure from PES in the amount of Twelve Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$12,326.54).

Section 2. The funds for the parts and maintenance shall be paid from the Parks Fund (#2171).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to PES in the amount of \$12,326.54 upon final approval of the Public Works Director.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
