

RESOLUTION G2022-22

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE JOINT PURCHASE OF A STREET SWEEPER FROM JACK DOHENY COMPANIES INC. WITH SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHT-FOUR DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$131,384.50)

WHEREAS, it has already been determined by the Public Works Director that a street sweeper is as necessary piece of equipment that will help the township to maintain the storm drains and gutters throughout the township on all subdivision streets; and

WHEREAS, a street sweeper will help the township to be in compliance with the Ohio EPA mandate for clean water when it enters the catch basins because it can be used to keep the gutters clean from debris; and

WHEREAS, Sycamore Township is interested in jointly purchasing and maintaining a street sweeper with Symmes Township and has agreed to help fund the purchase and will store the vehicle in their maintenance garage; and

WHEREAS, Symmes Township has determined that the purchase of a street sweeper is within the purchasing parameters of the American Rescue Plan Act because the money can be used to fund storm related projects; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to maintain the roads for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the general public and the street sweeper will be used to maintain the gutters and storm drains in Symmes Township; and

WHEREAS Symmes Township participates in the Ohio State Bid program therefore the Township would not be required to bid out the truck to multiple vendors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the joint purchase of a street sweeper from Jack Doheny Companies Inc. in an amount of \$131,384.50.

Section 2. That the appropriations for the American Rescue Plan Act #2272 be increased from \$0.00 to to \$1,435,994.70 for line item 2272-730-592-0000 and the Gas Tax Appropriation be increased \$20,000.00 for line item 2021-760-750-0000 from \$0.00 to \$20,000.00.

Section 3. The funds for the street sweeper shall be taken from the Gas Tax Fund (#2021), the ARPA Fund (#2272) and the TIF Fund (#2902).

Section 4. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to Amberly Village in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00 once the tractor and mower has been delivered and the Public Works Director has given final approval.

Section 5. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 7. Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.
