

RESOLUTION G2023-76

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A JOINT AGREEMENT BETWEEN HAMILTON COUNTY AND THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES OF SYMMES TOWNSHIP FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL PREEMPTION SYSTEM ON LOVELAND MADEIRA ROAD

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to install a traffic signal preemption system for use by fire emergency equipment in the traffic signals located as listed in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the signal preemption system requires the installation of certain equipment in the COUNTY’S traffic signal controller that will permit the signal to be preempted by fire emergency equipment entering the intersection; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP has submitted documentation/information regarding the equipment to be installed in the controller, a copy of which is marked Attachment 1, is affixed hereto, and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has reviewed and approved the documentation/information submitted by the TOWNSHIP; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, has agreed to enter into a Joint Agreement Between Hamilton County and the Board of Township Trustees of Symmes Township for the Installation of a Traffic Signal Preemption System on Loveland Madeira Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township of Hamilton County, Ohio hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to enter into a Joint Agreement Between Hamilton County and the Board of Township Trustees of Symmes Township for the installation of a traffic signal Preemption System on Loveland Madeira Road.

Section 2. The purpose of said agreement is to allow Symmes Township and the City of Loveland to install the preemption equipment in the traffic controllers at each intersection along Loveland Madeira from N. Lebanon Road to State Route 126 that are in control of the Hamilton County Engineer’s

Office and said township and city will then be responsible for maintenance of the preemption devices from this point forward.

Section 3. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
