

RESOLUTION G2023-74

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A LAWNMOWER FOR
THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT FROM KOENIG EQUIPMENT IN THE
AMOUNT OF ELEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE
DOLLARS CENTS (\$11,675.00)**

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Public Works Director that a replacement mower is now needed due to the failure of an existing mower; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended to the Township Administrator that the lawnmower replace an existing mower owned by the township; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain the parks and rights-of-ways for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Township participates in the State of Ohio, State Term Discount Program; therefore the Township would not be required to bid out the equipment to multiple vendors; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §505.261, the Board of Trustees shall devise plans for the maintenance and improvement of the park and award all contracts for maintenance and improvement in the manner provided by the law governing township trustees in awarding contracts for public improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the purchase of a lawnmower for the service department from Koenig Equipment in the amount of Eleven Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Five (\$11,675.00).

Section 2. The funds for the park lawnmower shall be taken from the Gas Tax Funds (#2021), Park Levy Fund (#2171), and the Rozzi Park Levy Fund (#2172).

Section 4. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to Deere and Company in the amount of \$11,675.00.

Section 5. Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning

and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 6. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
