

RESOLUTION G2023-71

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF ADAM CORNETTE TO THE POSITION OF CONSERVATION AND PARKS TECHNICIAN MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Symmes Township Trustees recently created the position of Conservation and Parks Technician Manager and wish to fill that position; and

WHEREAS, a job description for that position was also approved by the Board of Trustees and the position will report directly to the Township Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Township Trustees are responsible for hiring all personnel in the township when there are new positions and vacancies; and

WHEREAS, the Township Trustees recently interviewed potential candidates for that position; and

WHEREAS, the Township Trustees agree and approve the salary range from \$33.30 per hour to \$38.55 per hour for the Service Worker 3 and Parks and Conservation Technician Manager; and

WHEREAS, Adam Cornette is by reason of their education, training and experience the most competent to fill that position; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Trustees hire Adam Cornette as a Full-Time employee with the Parks Department beginning June 26, 2023, and with all the same benefits that all other Full-Time employees have per the personnel manual; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Township authorizes the hiring of Adam Cornette as the Conservation and Parks Technician Manager in the Parks Department effective June 26, 2023.

Section 2. The starting hourly rate for this position will be Thirty-Eight Dollars and Fifty-Five Cents (\$38.55) per hour and will include all benefits given to all other Full-Time Employees. Mr. Cornette will be eligible for an increase in salary at the same time as all the other employees at the end of 2023.

Section 3. This offer of employment also includes transfer of all sick leave time from

their previous government position, credit for three weeks of vacation, two personal days as well as credit for previous years of employment with other governments.

Section 4. Finds and determines that all formal action of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio revised Code Section 121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

Section 5. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
