

RESOLUTION G2023-48

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADDITIONAL EXPENSE OF A SECOND SEWER TAP TO SERVE THE NEW PUBLIC WORKS GARAGE FOR THE UNION CEMETERY ROAD LOCAL SEWER PROJECT WITH THE METROPOLITAN SEWER DISTRICT (MSD) AND SMITH CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,000.00 FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$25,000.00

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Sewer District received a petition from landowners in Symmes Township on Union Cemetery Road to extend sewer to their properties from Commerce Drive north toward Montgomery Road; and

WHEREAS, the work for this improvement involves construction of approximately 400 linear feet of 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer and other sanitary sewer appurtenances. The sewer is anticipated to be laid beneath the north side of Union Cemetery Road along the south side of the assessed property and will provide the assessed property with access to the public sanitary sewer located beneath the north side of Union Cemetery Road; and

WHEREAS, the Township did not object to the petition and is requesting that the assessed property at 9310 Union Cemetery Road be included in the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees have determined that they parcel owned by the township needs sewer for future development and agrees to the assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Township also intends to build a new public works garage at its current location of 9323 Union Cemetery Road which is directly across the street from the sewer project and would like an additional sewer tap installed to serve the new garage and Smith Construction will directly bill the Township for that additional tap fee in the amount of \$12,500.00; and

WHEREAS, MSD's final cost of the assessment will now be \$12,500.00 for each property owner and the township will need to authorize an additional \$500.00 for that assessment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio takes the following action:

Section 1. That the Township Administrator is authorized to sign an agreement with Smith Construction for an additional sewer tap for the Union Cemetery Road Local Sewer Project with the Metropolitan Sewer District.

- Section 2.** That the Township Trustees authorize the additional expense for a second sewer tap for the 9323 Union Cemetery property in order to serve the new public works garage that will be built in 2023/2024.
- Section 3.** That the Township Trustees authorize an additional \$500.00 for the assessment from MSD for the original sewer tap for the property located at 9310 Union Cemetery Road.
- Section 4.** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to expend funds to pay for the assessment from the General Fund and ARPA Fund (#1000 and #2272) in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$25,000.00).
- Section 5.** The Board of Trustees of Symmes Township upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.
- Section 6.** It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 7.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
