

**RESOLUTION G2023-12**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE TWO (2) LIGHT TOWERS FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT FROM UNITED RENTALS IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$17,600.00)**

**WHEREAS**, the township needs portable lights for many reasons for the road department and occasionally for special events held in the park; and

**WHEREAS**, United Rentals has two used portable light towers for sale and the Public Works Director is requesting that the township purchase them for their use on the roads and parks; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to maintain the roads and parks for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the general public and the light towers will be used to help maintain all of the roadways in Symmes Township during emergencies at night and in the parks for special events; and

**WHEREAS**, Symmes Township participates in the Ohio State Bid program therefore the Township would not be required to bid out the truck to multiple vendors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Symmes Township Trustees agree to purchase two (2) lights towers for the Service Department to be used for emergencies and special events.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

**Section 1.** The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to purchase two (2) light towers from United Rentals in an amount not to exceed \$17,600.00.

**Section 2.** The funds for the light towers shall be taken from the Motor Vehicle License Fund (#2011) and the Park Fund (#2171).

**Section 3.** That the appropriations in the Motor Vehicle License Fund (#2011) line item 2011-760-740-0000 be increased \$8,800.00 for a total of \$\$8,800.00 and the Parks Fund (#2171) line item 2171-760-740-0000 be increased \$8,800.00.

**Section 4.** The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to United Rentals in an amount not to exceed \$17,600.00 once the light towers

have been delivered and the Public Works Director has given final approval.

**Section 5.** Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**Section 7.** Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.
