

**RESOLUTION G2019-26**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN  
A CONTRACT WITH ROZZI TO PURCHASE FIREWORKS FOR THE  
FIRECRACKER FESTIVAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00**

**WHEREAS**, the Little Miami River Chamber of Commerce sponsors a fourth of July festival for the Symmes Township and Loveland Communities each year and has done so for many years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little Miami River Chamber of Commerce will hold their festival at Symmes Park on June 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little Miami River Chamber of Commerce has asked the Township to sponsor a portion of the festival to help with costs and the Trustees have indicated that they would like to again sponsor the fireworks portion of the festival; and

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees feel that it is in their best interest to provide community events and programming and to help those non-profit entities who also want to serve the community and provide for a family atmosphere; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Administrator has reviewed this cost for the event and finds that it is a reasonable expense and will be great for the community and found a co-sponsor for the fireworks so the amount was increase from last year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Trustees have decided to participate as a sponsor of the Firecracker Festival and pay for the fireworks portion of the event to help out the Little Miami River Chamber Alliance in the amount of \$5,000.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

**Section 1.** The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to sign a contract with Rozzi to purchase fireworks for the Firecracker Festival in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$5,000.00).

**Section 2.** The funds for this sponsorship shall be taken from the General Fund (#1).

**Section 4.** The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to Rozzi in the amount of \$5,000.00 (\$1,000.00 up front as a deposit and the remainder after the event).

**Section 5.** Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**Section 6.** Finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without limitation) Ohio Revised Code §121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.

**Section 7.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
