

RESOLUTION G2020-64

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH JK MEURER CORPORATION IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FIVE DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$15,805.00) TO MAKE REPAIRS TO THE TRAIL AT HOPEWELL MEADOWS PARK

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Trustees that the existing trail at Hopewell Meadows Park needs repairs due to tree root damage; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended to the Township Administrator that parts of the trail at Hopewell Meadows Park be repaired; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain the parks for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has reviewed all bids and finds that JK Meurer Corporation to have the best bid; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §505.261, the Board of Trustees shall devise plans for the maintenance and improvement of the park and award all contracts for maintenance and improvement in the manner provided by the law governing township trustees in awarding contracts for public improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to enter into an agreement with JK Meurer Corporation in the amount of \$15,805.00 to repairs sections of the existing trail at Hopewell Meadows Park.

Section 2. The funds for the trail repairs shall be taken from the Parks Levy Fund (#12A).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to JK Meurer Corporation in the amount of \$15,805.00 upon final approval of the Public Works Director.

Section 4. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of

this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 5. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and that all deliberations of the Board were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
