

RESOLUTION G2017-07

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF STREET PAVING BIDS AND
AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO BARRETT PAVING IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$323,884.70**

WHEREAS, on February 19th and 26th Symmes Township advertised for paving in the newspaper and website and set a bid date of March 3, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain certain streets for the safe and effective operation of Symmes Township public works services and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received for the 2017 paving program

1. JK Meurer Corp - \$328,469.64
2. John R. Jurgensen - \$418,838.40
3. Barrett Paving - \$323,884.70

WHEREAS, bids were accepted and reviewed by the Public Works Director and the Township Administrator recommends that the Trustees award the contract to Barrett Paving in the amount of \$323,884.70; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §5571.01, the Board of Trustees may construct, reconstruct, resurface, or improve any public road or part thereof under its jurisdiction within its township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby accept the bids for the paving in the Township and award the bid to Barrett Paving in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$323,884.70).

Section 2. The Township Administrator is authorized to sign the contract and complete any necessary paperwork to award the bid.

Section 3. The funds for the paving shall be taken from the Road District Fund (#11).

Section 4. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to Barrett

Paving in the amount of \$323,884.70 once the work is finished and the Public Works Director has given final approval of the project.

Section 5. Upon majority vote does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 7th day of March, 2017 by and between the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, hereinafter designated as the Owner, and Barrett Paving Materials, Inc., 3751 Commerce Drive, Franklin, OH 45005, hereinafter designated as the Contractor.

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WITNESSETH: That the Contractor has agreed, and by these presents does agree with the Owner for the consideration herein below mentioned, to furnish at Contractor's own proper cost and expense all necessary materials and labor of every description, and to carry out complete, in good, firm and substantial manner the **2017 Resurfacing Project** all of which shall be done and performed in accordance with the general conditions, drawings, surveys, plats, cross-sections, profiles, plans and specifications, including all modifications thereof, if any, incorporated in the documents before their execution and by reference hereby become a part of this contract.

The provision contained in the "Legal Notice", in "Information for Bidders", in "Director of Public Works's Estimate", in the "Proposal", and in the "Specifications", as well as in the surveys, plats, cross-sections and profiles for this work on file in the office of the Board of Trustees, are also hereby combined, and incorporated by reference thereto, as part of this agreement.

The Contractor shall pay into the State Insurance Fund the amount of premium determined and fixed by the Industrial Commission of Ohio, promptly when due, or elect to pay compensation direct and contribute to the surplus of the fund as provided by law. The Contractor and his Surety agree to indemnify the Township against liability and loss by reason of the breach of the obligation of this paragraph and agree that it shall run to the benefit of the Industrial Commission of Ohio and the State Insurance Fund for the recovery of premiums that should have been paid. All of the foregoing provisions of this paragraph shall be equally binding upon each sub-contractor whose performance thereof is warranted by the Contractor who employs such sub-contractor. The Township may require of the Contractor as a condition of permitting the beginning or continuance of work a certificate of compliance with this paragraph issued by the Industrial Commission of Ohio.


In consideration whereof, the Owner hereby agrees and promises to pay to the Contractor, at the times, under the conditions and in the manner provided in the specifications, and in full of all compensation for material furnished or work done thereunder, at the unit prices, stated in the proposal, the sum of \$323,884.70.


