

RESOLUTION G2017-35

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE SALT FOR THE ROAD DEPARTMENT FROM MORTON SALT IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$12,000.00)

WHEREAS, the Township Road Department is responsible for roads and sidewalks maintenance throughout the township; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has indicated to the Township Administrator that the salt supply needs to be replenished from use during the 2016/2017 winter season; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Township Trustees that salt is a necessary safety item that needs to be purchased every year when necessary and the Administrator is authorized to purchase salt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Symmes Township, Hamilton County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Symmes Township Trustees hereby authorize the Township Administrator to purchase salt for the Road Department from Morton Salt in an amount not to exceed Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00).

Section 2. The funds for the salt shall be taken from the Road Levy Fund (#11).

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payment to the necessary vendors once approval has been given by the Public Works Director.



Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by-law.




